CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

DANNY ZUKO

Age range: 20's

Vocal: Rock Bari/Tenor D3-B4

Charming middle class bad boy and natural leader, strong and confident but can buckle in a second at the sight of the girl of his dreams. Likeable and with an air of easy-going charm. Good dancer.

RIZZO

Age range: 20's Vocal: Alto A3-C5

Leader of the Pink Ladies. Comes from a dysfunctional home life so has had to present a tough façade. Unlucky in love, she has a sly wit, sarcastic and outspoken. Vulnerable to the world around her. Good dancer.

FRENCHY

Age range: 20's

Vocal: Alto/Mezzo A3-D5

A dreamer; good-natured and warm, a great listener, fussy about her appearance, particularly her hair. She can't wait to finish high school so she can be a beautician. Good dancer.

MARTY

Age range: 20's Vocal: Mezzo C4-C5

Glamorous with a slightly older sensibility but young at heart. Forever trying to be the sophisticated one. Good dancer.





JAN

Age range: 20's Vocal: Alto A3-C5

Funny and the loudest in the room, compulsive eater, awkward by nature. Loud and pushy with the girls, but total opposite when it comes to the boys. Good dancer.

DOODY

Age range: 20's **Vocal:** Tenor D3-A4

The youngest of the guys; Middle class with a boyish charm and open, with a disarming smile and hero-worshiping attitude towards the other guys. Good dancer.

KENICKIE

Age range: 20's

Vocal: Bari/Tenor C3-F4

The second in command after Danny; Middle class; he has an edge. Tough exterior but deep down there is a softness and a vulnerability Has a sharp tongue and an offbeat sense of humour. Good dancer.

SONNY

Age range: 20's

Vocal: Bari/Tenor D3-A4

Middle class Italian/American. Very much part of the Danny/Kenickie gang; fast talking. A real salesman and a wheeler-dealer who thinks he's a real lady-killer. Good dancer.





VINCE FONTAINE (Cover only)

Age range: N/A

Vocal: Bari/Tenor G3-E4

Charming 'teen audience' disc jockey; slick, egotistical and fast-talking. He is also a veteran "Greaser." Good mover.

ROGER

Age range: 20's

Vocal: Bari/Tenor D3-A4

The anything-for-a-laugh stocky type of boy; Middle class; a clown who enjoys winding people up, he is full of mischief and is always dreaming up half-baked schemes and ideas. Good dancer.

CHA CHA, a.k.a. Charlene DiGregorio

Age range: 20's to 30's

The best dancer at St. Bernadette's; a loud-mouth, she wins the dancing competition with Danny. Ensemble singing and a great dancer.
